## Directions

From Philadelphia: Take 1-76 West to Exit 331A (Blue Route/1-476 South) **on the left** toward Chester. Take exit 13 (East Lancaster Ave./US-30E) toward Villanova. In about 0.6 miles, turn left onto King of Prussia Rd. In approximately 0.1 mile, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> Centocor driveway on the right with the Centocor sign, and use the parking lot in front of the building.

From Points North and West: Get to Blue Route/I-476 South toward Chester. Take exit 13 (East Lancaster Ave./US-30E) toward Villanova. In about 0.6 miles, turn left onto King of Prussia Rd. In approximately 0.1 mile, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> Centocor driveway on the right with the Centocor sign, and use the parking lot in front of the building.

From Points South: Get to Blue Route/I-476 North toward Plymouth Meeting. Take Exit 13 (US-30 exit) toward St. David's/Villanova. Ramp becomes King of Prussia Rd. In approximately 0.1 mile, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> Centocor driveway on the right with the Centocor sign, and use the parking lot in front of the building.

- Septa Regional Rail R5 Paoli/Thorndale – Get off at Radnor Station. It is a short walk to Centocor.
- Septa Rt.100 High Speed Line – Take the Market-Frankford Line (“the El”) West to 69<sup>th</sup> Street. Transfer to Rt.100 on upper level. Get off at Radnor Station. It is a short walk to Centocor.
