G. Scott Lett, Ph.D.

Dr. G. Scott Lett will present some challenges and successes, in the context of recent research directed at finding improvements in the treatment of breast cancer. Examples will include the development of new diagnostics, employing fresh approaches to using fluorescence, image analysis, and data management in a collaborative environment. Co-founder and CEO of [The BioAnalytics Group](#) LLC, Dr. Lett is a mathematician, engineer, and entrepreneur, with experience in the spacecraft, energy and biomedical industries. He has served as a permanent member of the NIH Modeling and Analysis of Biological Systems (MABS) study section, and is an Adjunct Professor in the Biomedical Engineering Department of The College of New Jersey.
