They will be expected to teach lectures and laboratories in Biochemistry, and establish a strong externally funded research group in **Experimental Biochemistry**. Members of the Chemistry Department are active participants in the recently created Center for Computational and Integrative Biology (CCIB) on the Rutgers University-Camden campus. The CCIB started new Masters and Doctoral programs in 2010. The review process will begin November 15<sup>th</sup> 2011, and continue until the position is filled.
